## Walking for a happy and healthy childhood

Over 180 enthusiastic participants came together at 'Walkathon for a Cause' in Singapore to support Akshaya Patra's mission to serve mid-day meals to children in India and, more importantly, keep them in school.

This community morning walk, held in May 2025, raised funds for 1,67,000 mid-day meals for children. It will support 720 government school children with school lunch for a full academic year. With over 200 people reached and 80 physically participating, the Walkathon fostered new bonds, energised the community and contributed to a meaningful cause.



The biogas plant is expected to generate 145 NM3 (55 kgs of LPG equivalent) of biogas per day, with a capacity of 1.6 tons per day. This sustainable solution will not only reduce our carbon footprint but also yield significant cost savings every month.

### Morning Star brings colours to education

In Mumbai, Morning Star's team of 75 volunteers made vibrant contribution in Panvel, Maharashtra, transforming a school with a fresh coat of colourful paint. Through their enthusiastic efforts in school painting, they created an exciting and welcoming environment adorned with vibrant cartoons. This initiative not only beautified the school but also boosted children's enthusiasm, encouraged learning and promoted increased school attendance.
